Our Programs

Empowerment through Education

This program gives full educational support to orphan abandoned and marginalized children. Children are given educational opportunities. They are encouraged to follow their interests and the necessary tools are given to them.

Women Empowerment

This program helps marginalized women get support by forming Mother Groups which encourages saving and new business ventures, provides microcredit and encourages literacy. This program has helped break the cycle of poverty for 600 women.

Integrated Support to Vulnerable Groups (ISVG)

This program includes various necessary development and welfare activities like scholarship, health post upgrade, school water purification, children health camp, Improving ECD Classroom at government schools, building houses, toilet, etc. to the underprivileged groups of Dang Deukhuri.

Sickle Cell Screening

This program includes the screening of sickle cells in Tharu communities in Dang Deukhuri. It is a genetic life-threatning disease which has no cure. CPN is initiating blood screening and treatment in our working areas by supporting lab equipments to health posts. Awareness programs about the disease is also done through various means.

Children and Youth Empowerment

Besides the education program, CPN conducts various right-based activities for children and youth. Communication skills, mentorship and vocational training is given to children and youth in order to prepare them for adulthood.

Bicycle Distrubution

This program launched in 2011 and has been distributing bicycles to students to motivate them to go to school, make traveling easier and safer and save time on travel as well as for daily chores. School drop out rates have dropped. Mothers are provided with bicycles to promote their business.
